MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR


Dear Friends,

Greetings! This week our focus is on spiritual gifts. If we look at 1 Corinthians 12, we see that our spiritual gifts are like parts of the body. Every part belongs and has a reason for being in the body. Every part needs the other parts. Our individual spiritual gifts collectively serve a purpose in the body of Metropolitan as a whole.

How do you discover the gifts God has given you through faith? 1) You spend time praying to the One that gave you the gift. Like an apprentice who asks the master craftsman how to use a tool, your prayerful questions will lead you to God's plans for why He has given you the gift. The Giver of the gift is the best guide to show you how to use it. 2) You study the Bible. God has revealed his purposes for your spiritual gifts in the Bible. Go to the Bible first, then, read what others have written about the gifts. 3) You ask those who know you the best. Since your spiritual gift is intended to be lived out in the community, those who know you best can help you discover how God has gifted you for service. Listen to what others in your community of faith say about how you function as a follower of Jesus. 4) Serve! The best way to learn how God has gifted you to serve as a member of the body of Christ is to serve. Start with what you are asked to do and see what makes your heart beat fast or what comes easiest to you.

Often times we think God always asks us to do what we can't do and what we don't want to do. It makes more sense that we do what we love to do for God, it may be the very thing He gifted us to do all along for him.

God has placed a gift under the tree for you to open. Who do you know that would have a gift for him or her and not open? You know you wouldn't. Now is the time for you to begin to unwrap the gift that God has uniquely designed for you.

Christlike Ways to Respond to Dishonesty and Scams

Every year, at an annual credit union members' meeting, one of the board members ends the meeting, by saying, "Everyday, someone is trying to separate you from your money." Although there are a number of individuals and organizations with good intentions, there are just as many without. We can make good decisions to avoid the consequences of their actions. Protecting yourself from being scammed can be done, while still embodying Christlike compassion. These Christlike strategies, rooted in scripture, can help you to balance compassion with caution, ensuring that you can assist those in need without falling prey to scams.

- **1. Discernment: Judge well.** Pray for wisdom to discern genuine needs. James 1:5 If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God."
- **2. Setting Boundaries: Clearly define personal limits.** Establish what you can and cannot do. Proverbs 4:23 "Above all else, guard your heart."
- **3. Verification: Confirm the truth.** Verify stories before offering help. 1 John 4:1 "Do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits."
- **4. Community Resources: Utilize local support systems.** Direct individuals to church or community aid. Acts 2:44-45 "They gave to anyone who had need."
- **5. Education: Learn about common scams.** Stay informed about fraudulent schemes. Hosea 4:6 "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge."
- **6. Accountability: Have others to help keep you responsible.** Work in pairs when helping others. Ecclesiastes 4:9-10 "Two are better than one."
- **7. Prayer: Seek divine guidance.** Pray before making a decision about giving. Philippians 4:6 "In every situation, by prayer and petition.
- **8. Documentation: Keep records of aid given.** Document interactions and assistance. 1 Corinthians 14:40 "But everything should be done in a fitting and orderly way."
- **9. Empathy: Understand others' feelings.** Show compassion without compromising safety. Colossians 3:12 "Clothe yourselves with compassion."
- 10. Counsel: Seek advice from trusted sources. Consult with church leaders on how to help. Proverbs 11:14 "In the multitude of counselors there is safety."
- **11. Awareness: Be alert to your surroundings.** Be mindful of suspicious behavior. 1 Peter 5:8 "Be alert and of sober mind."
- 12. Generosity: Give wisely. Provide support that encourages self-sufficiency.
- 2 Corinthians 9:7 God loves a cheerful giver."

- **13. Stewardship: Manage resources responsibly.** Allocate resources where they are most impactful. Luke 16:10 "Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much.
- **14. Love: Act out of genuine care.** Ensure acts are motivated by love, not obligation. 1 Corinthians 13:4-5 "Love is patient, love is kind.
- 15. Transparency: Be open about intentions. Be clear about how you can help.
- 2 Corinthians 8:21 "We are taking pains to do what is right."
- **16. Non-monetary Aid: Offer help without money.** Provide food, clothing, or other necessities. Acts 3:6 "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give to you."
- **17. Referral: Connect with appropriate services.** Refer individuals to professional help. Matthew 25:35-36 "I was hungry and you gave me something to eat."
- **18. Listening: Give your time and attention.** Listen to their stories without quick judgment. James 1:19 "Everyone should be quick to listen."
- **19. Wisdom: Apply knowledge appropriately.** Use wisdom to navigate complex situations. Proverbs 2:6 "For the Lord gives wisdom.
- **20. Guarded Generosity: Protect yourself while giving.** Give in ways that do not compromise your safety. Matthew 10:16 "Be as shrewd as snakes and as innocent as doves."
- **21. Respect: Treat everyone with dignity.** Show respect regardless of the situation. Romans 12:10 "Honor one another above yourselves."
- **22. Community Involvement: Engage in collective action.** Participate in group efforts to help those in need. Hebrews 10:24–25 "Spur one another on toward love and good deeds."
- **23. Support Networks: Create a supportive community.** Develop a network for those in need. Galatians 6:2 "Carry each other's burdens."
- **24. Forgiveness: Let go of resentment.** Forgive those who may have attempted to deceive. Matthew 6:14 "For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you."






